Student Presenter Award

This award provides \$599 to students who are authors of accepted papers/posters for the HFES Annual Meeting. The student must be listed as the presenting author of the work at the time of submission.

Students must be members of HFES at the time of application and must provide their membership number. To join HFES, see the online form at:

Nominations for this award must be submitted by a faculty member in the student's program. (The nominator does not have to be an advisor or co-author of the work). Only one nomination per faculty member is allowed.

Awards will be made by committee. The committee will consider applications holistically with an emphasis on supporting travel for students where 1) the work is primarily the student's rather than the result of an established/ongoing research project or group; 2) the work is substantively contributing to the student's degree program (e.g., serves as a part of a thesis or required project); 3) the work is not funded or was funded by a source that would not typically provide travel expenses.

Students may apply to both this and the First Year student travel award, but may not receive both. Students will first be considered for the First Year award and if not selected will be considered for the Student Presenter award.

Students who have previously received either the First Year student travel award, or the Student Presenter award, from COTG are not eligible for either award.

Students will receive the award as a check in US Dollars from HFES. Also, the registration fee for the conference will be waived for award recipients. Students will be notified regarding the award prior to the early-bird registration deadline and (if they are receiving an award) will be provided with special registration instructions. Please do not register/pay the fee prior to notification.

Applications are due 5 PM Eastern Time, May 15. (Verify date and contact when call to "Apply for Annual Meeting Support Awards" appears in the May Bulletin)
